Purpose -

- To enhance and promote the training and racing environment for our elite regional swimmers prior to the Australian Age National Championships 2026.
- To provide a pathway for our younger swimmers to aspire to as they move through the regional and state levels of competition.
- To provide role models to inspire and motivate our younger swimmers at a local level.

Eligibility Criteria

- swimmers with at least 1 Australian Age National Championships 2025 QT for events 100m and above
- 13y boys with 1 QLD LC State Championships 2025 QT for events 100m and above
- swimmers who are close to the Australian Age National Championships 2025 QT plus a margin as below-

Team Expectations prior to commencing the Camp

- It is expected that all athletes attending the camp are 100% fit and fully capable of completing all training sessions and racing activities. This camp is not suitable for athletes' carrying injuries, illness, or returning from extended breaks.
- In addition, all athletes are expected to have resumed full training after Christmas and to have completed at least four weeks of consistent, uninterrupted training prior to the start of the camp.
- The primary objective of this camp is to support athletes in achieving peak performance at the Country Championships.
- Therefore, it is expected that all participants plan and undertake their training accordingly, ensuring they are well-prepared through a consistent training block of at least four weeks following the Christmas break.
