KEY DETAILS

- 1. This meet has been designed to provide a quality racing opportunity for swimmers prior to nominating for the FNQ Short Course Championships.
- 2. This meet is open to Swimming Queensland registered competitive swimmers, other swimmers may enter if they meet state, territory or country clearance criteria.
- 3. Age will be calculated as at the first day of this meet.
- 4. Entries are to be completed online via Swim Central using the link available on our website. Entries close Midnight, Monday 18th July 2022.
- 5. Entry Fees: Online Meet Entry \$5/event excluding all surcharges.
- 6. Late entries will be accepted up until 30 minutes prior to the meet start time and incur a fee of \$15 per event.
- 7. Spectator Entry \$3/adult.
- 8. An online program will be published on ours and FNQ website on the Thursday prior to the meet. No printed programs will be available.
- 9. A timekeeper roster will be confirmed and published as part of the program. Please contact your Club to volunteer. Timekeeping is allocated by the number of swimmers entered from each club.
- 10. Results will also be viewable on Meet Mobile. Results will be multi-aged as per Swimming Queensland Competition
- 11. Ribbons or Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for ages 8&U, 9, 10 & 11 year olds in 50m, 100m, 200m and 400IM events.
- 12. Heats are seeded fastest to slowest. Heats may be amalgamated or re-seeded at the discretion of the Technical Manager and Referee.
- 13. Protests must be submitted in writing to the Referee by a responsible team leader, together with a deposit of \$100, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the respective event.
- 14. All Swimming Queensland Rules, SAL and FINA Swimming Rules will apply at this meet.
- 15. In nominating, swimmers agree that they may be photographed/videoed by TAS Swimming and these images may also be used by TAS Swimming at its discretion.
- 16. We have a shared responsibility to ensure the safe running of events. We appreciate your support in making this happen by maintaining physical distancing, good hand hygiene, staying at home, and getting tested if you have symptoms.
