Conditions of Entry

- 1. The meet will be conducted under the rules of FINA and By-laws of Swimming Australia (SAL) and Swimming Queensland (SQ).
- 2. All competitors must be currently registered members of an affiliated SAL club.
- 3. Visitors are welcome to nominate.
- 4. SWD swimmers must present to the referee of the day.
- 5. **Minimum age for the meet is 8 years**. Age shall be as at 4th March 2023.
- 6. NT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED (Short Course Converted times will be accepted).
- 7. FNQ Swimming reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and events. Times on the flyer are an indication only and a timeline will be published at the time of preparing the programme.
- 8. **Nomination Fee**: Individual events AGE 8-10 \$5.00 (50m events ONLY), all other Individual events AGE 10&over \$7.50. Relays \$10.00. All individual nominations through Swim Central.
- Relay NOMINATIONS will be accepted as either through swim central or manual entries. The swim central nominations will close same time as individual events. The manual relay nominations MUST be emailed to Alice Foote <u>race-sec@fnqswimming.com.au</u> BEFORE Saturday 25 February 2023 11.59PM.
- 10. LATE NOMINATIONS: Late nominations will be accepted up to 30 minutes before the commencement of the First Session of the Championships. NO LATE NOMINATIONS will be accepted after this time. NO RESEEDING of events will occur because of late nominations. The late nomination swimmer will be entered into the last heat of the event. If there is no space available in the last heat, an additional heat will be created and the swimmers in the last heat may be reseeded according to their seed times. Late nominations incur a fee of \$20.00 per event and must be emailed or delivered to Alice Foote race-sec@fnqswimming.com.au
- 11. Relays: 2 teams per club only to be entered per relay event.
- 12. Change/Substitution of relay swimmers will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the relay events on each day. (ie 30 minutes prior to event 21 and 30 minutes prior to event 49)
- 13. Events 21, 26, 49 and 54 are mixed relays. The relays must consist of 2 females and 2 males and swum in any order.
- 14. Swimmers are allowed to compete in any number of relays as long as they are competing within the correct age criteria of the relay.
- 15. Programmes available on the FNQ website prior to the commencement of the Championships. Limited number of programmes available at the meet.
- 16. In the event of a protest, a fee of \$100 is to be deposited with a written protest not later than 30 minutes following the conclusion of the event (SAL CBL 12).
- 17. This is an FNQ Swimming run event and all clubs will be allocated tasks for the weekend.
- 18. It is a condition of entering this event that your club understands that timekeeping is required by all clubs and is allocated by the number of swimmers your club enters.

Photo Policy

19. In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed and that the images may be used in publications, FNQ Website or social media sites.





Awards

- 20. Swimmers aged 8, 9 & 10 will be awarded a **Complete Swimmer** medal upon **completion** of all four 50m events. (Event numbers: Boys 13, 17, 39, 45; Girls 14, 18, 40, 46)
- 21. Swimmers aged 11 will be awarded a **Complete Swimmer** medal upon **completion** of all four 100m events. (Event numbers: Boys 9, 11, 35, 37; Girls 10, 12, 36, 38)
- 22. Medals will be awarded to the first three place getters in each age group for 8, 9 and 10 years 50m events (Event numbers: Boys 13, 17, 39, 45; Girls 14, 18, 40, 46)
- 23. Medals will be awarded to the first three place getters aged 11 years in the 100m events (Event numbers: Boys 9, 11, 35, 37; Girls 10, 12, 36, 38)
- 24. 10 year old swimmers competing in the 100m events will be swimming for times only.10 year old swimmers competing in 200m IM will compete for points towards the age champion for 10 yrs.
- 25. 11 year old swimmers competing in the 200m individual stroke events will be swimming for times only. 11 year old swimmers competing in 200m IM will compete for points towards the age champion for 11 yrs.
- 26. 12&O swimmers will be multi aged for award medals (12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17&O) in the individual event numbers 1, 2, 9, 10, 11, 12, 35, 36, 37, 38 (ie all 100m events and the 200IM). All other individual events awards will be presented to the first three place-getters only.
- 27. Multi-class (SWD) swimmers will be awarded medals in all 50m events. There is no separate multi-class event, these swimmers will enter the relevant events to promote and encourage inclusivity and competitiveness.
- 28. Awards will be presented for all first three place getters in all relay events.
- 29. Awards for age champion winners, runners up and third place getters in the following age groups: 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, 16, 17&Over and Multi-class (SWD) Points allocated are:
 - FIRST 10points, SECOND 7points, THIRD 5points, FOURTH 3points, FIFTH 2 points, SIXTH 1 point.
- 30. Visitors do not score points but will receive a medal for placing.
- 31. Age Champions will be determined by points accrued in the following (you do not have to do all events to be eligible for the award):
 - i. 8 and 9 years 50m of each stroke
 - (Event Nos: 13, 14, 17, 18, 39, 40, 45, 46)
 - ii. 10 years 50m of each stroke and 200IM
 (Event Nos: 1, 2, 13, 14, 17, 18, 39, 40, 45, 46)
 - iii. 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 years and 17&O 100m of each stroke plus 200IM (Event Nos: 1, 2, 9, 10, 11, 12, 35, 36, 37, 38)
 - iv. Multi-class 50m of each stroke
 (Event Nos: 5, 6, 13, 14, 17, 18, 19, 20, 31, 32, 39, 40, 43, 44, 45, 46) Enter into the relevant 50m age race.

Presentation of Age Champion, multi-class winners and overall club shields will be presented approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of the meet.
