It is with great pleasure Saints Swimming Club & Central Cairns Swimming would like to welcome you to our State Preparation Meet, being held at TAS Aquatic Centre. While the venue has changed from previous years due to unforeseen maintenance issues at Tobruk Memoria Pool, this is the sixth such meet we have hosted and after the positive response and performances last year we have kept the same format.

Our racing program is structured to give swimmers the best possible opportunity to qualify for QLD State, QLD Sprint and National Championships by allowing adequate recovery between sessions for quality competition.

The 50m events on the Friday night promises to be fast and furious, where we will be awarding cash prizes for 12yrs & under, 13years & over for the fastest overall combined time of 50Fly, 50Bk, 50Br & 50Fr, male and female.

For events on Saturday and Sunday we are awarding cash prizes for making State and/or National qualification in 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m & 1500m events for the first time. That is, if your entry time is over the qualification time and you make the qualification time at this meet. Cash prizes do not apply to time trial swims.

Conditions of Entry:

- 1. The meet will be conducted under the rules of FINA and By-laws of Swimming Australia (SAL) and Swimming Queensland (SQ).
- 2. All competitors must be currently registered members of an affiliated SAL club or a visiting member of a club in a FINA registered nation. SWD must present their classification card to the referee on the day.
- 3. All decisions taken will be at the discretion of the Chief Referee of the day.
- 4. In the event of a protest, a fee of \$100 is to be deposited with a written protest no later than 30 minutes following the conclusion of the event. (SAL CBL 12)
- 5. Late nominations will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to first session start time on the Saturday, at the discretion of the Meet Director. A \$15 per event late fee applies.
