CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The meet will be conducted under the rules of FINA and By-laws of Swimming Australia (SAL) and Swimming Queensland (SQ).
2. All competitors must be currently registered members of an affiliated SAL club or a visiting member of a club in a FINA registered nation. SWD must present their classification card to the referee of the day.
3. All decisions taken will be at the discretion of the Chief Referee of the day.
4. Age shall be as on Saturday 9th November 2024.
5. Ribbons will be awarded for the first 3 place getters in each age group from 8 to 16 years and over for the 25m, 50m and 100m events. Ribbons for the 200m and 400m events will be awarded for the overall 1st, 2nd and 3rd. There will be no age aggregate awards. 7 & under will receive participation ribbons.
6. **Nominations will be done for individual events via Swim Central. Nominations close Monday, 4th November 2024.** Late Nominations will not be accepted.
7. **Individual Events \$6.00 which includes FNQ \$1.50 surcharge, 8 & under 25m events \$3.50**
8. Programs will be available on the FNQ Swimming website.
9. In the event of a protest, a fee of \$100 is to be deposited with a written protest no later than 30 minutes following the conclusion of the event. (SAL CBL 12)
10. **8yrs & under must enter either 25m Rule Tolerances Swims or Open swims not both.**
11. In nominating for this Meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed and that the images may be used in publications, FNQ website or social media sites.
12. Multi-class (SWD) swimmers will be awarded ribbons in all events. There is no separate multi-class event, these swimmers will enter into the relevant events to promote and encourage inclusivity and competitiveness.
