

Terms and Conditions

Please Read these Conditions of Entry:

1. The meet will be conducted under the rules of FINA and By-laws of Swimming Australia (SAL) and Swimming Queensland (SQ).
2. All competitors must be currently registered members of an affiliated SAL club.
3. Visitors are welcome to nominate.
4. Multi-Class swimmers must present themselves to the referee of the day.
5. **Minimum age for the meet is 6 years.** Age shall be as at 4th of April 2025.
6. Tobruk Swim Club Incorporated reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and events. Times on the flyer are an indication only and a timeline will be published at the time of preparing the programme.
7. **NOMINATION FEE:** Individual events AGE 6-8 \$5.00 (25m events ONLY), all other Individual events AGE 8&over \$7.50. Relays \$10.00 per team. All individual nominations through Swim Central. (8 year olds can do either 25m or 50m events not both and the tolerance rule applies to 25 m events)
8. **Relay Nominations** will be accepted as either through swim central or manual entries. The swim central nominations will close same time as individual events. The manual relay nominations **MUST** be emailed to Jackie Armstrong jack3377@live.com.au **BEFORE FRIDAY 31st MARCH 2025 when nominations close.**
9. **Relay Teams:** Limit of 2 teams per club per event. Mixed relays will consist of 2 male and 2 female and swum in any order.
10. Swimmers are allowed to compete in any number of relays as long as they are competing within the correct age criteria of the relay.
11. **LATE NOMINATIONS will be accepted up to 30 minutes before the commencement of the FIRST SESSION of the event. NO LATE NOMINATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME.** NO RESEEDING of events will occur because of late nominations. The late nomination swimmer will be entered into the last heat of the event. If there is no space available in the last heat, an additional heat will be created and the swimmers in the last heat may be reseeded according to their seed times. Late nominations will incur a fee of \$20.00 per event and must be emailed or delivered to Jackie Armstrong jack3377@live.com.au
12. Programmes available on the FNQ website prior to the commencement of the event.
13. In the event of a protest, a fee of \$100 is to be deposited with a written protest not later than 30 minutes following the conclusion of the event (SAL CBL 12).
14. It is a condition of entering this event that your club understands that timekeeping is required by all clubs and is allocated by the number of swimmers your club enters.
