TIME TRIAL WILL BE AVAILABLE

As the closing date for Queensland Short Course Championships is 11.59pm on 29 July 2025, a swimmer will be allowed to swim a time trial for 50m, 100m and 200m events ONLY. The time trials will be held after Session 4 and before presentations. To be eligible to swim in a time trial the swimmers must be within 0.5, 1.0 and 2.0 seconds respectively of the Qld Short Course State qualifying time. The request must be from a coach and be delivered to the Officials tent no later than the start of event 57.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The meet will be conducted under rules of World Aquatics and By-laws of Swimming Australia (SAL) and Swimming Queensland (SQ).
- 2. All competitors must be currently registered members of an affiliated SAL club.
- 3. SWD must present themselves to the referee of the day before commencement of swimming of the first session they attend.
- 4. Minimum age for the meet is 8 years.
- 5. Age shall be as of 26th July 2025.
- 6. All swimmers must have a time to enter; **NT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**. Long Course converted times will be acceptable. Times need to have been achieved after 1 January 2022. Older times will not be acceptable.
- 7. FNQRSA reserves the right, on the day, to combine heats and events. Times on the flyer are an indication only; a draft timeline will be published at the time of preparing the program.
- **8. Nomination Fee**: Individual events AGE 8-10 \$5.00 (50m events ONLY), all other Individual events \$7.50. Relays \$10. This fee does not include any surcharges. All individual nominations will be done through the Swim Central.
- Relay Nominations: Will be accepted as either through swim central or manual entries. The Swim
 Central nominations will close the same time as Individual events. The manual relay nominations
 MUST be emailed to Alice Foote race-sec@fnqswimming.com.au BEFORE Wednesday 16th July 2025
 11.59pm.
- 10. **LATE NOMINATIONS** will be accepted up to 30 minutes before the commencement of the FIRST SESSION of the Championships.

NO LATE NOMINATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME.

NO RESEEDING of events will occur because of late nominations. The late nomination swimmer will be entered into the last heat of the event.

Late nominations will incur a fee of \$20.00 per event and must be emailed or delivered to Alice Foote race-sec@fnqswimming.com.au.

- 11. Entrance fee for any spectators will be \$3.00 per day.
- 12. **RELAY TEAMS** limit of two teams per club per event. Mixed relays will consist of 2 boys and 2 girls.
- 13. ** RELAY EVENT 59 this relay WILL NOT be awarded any points and will be run so we can get everyone involved and competing in a relay situation. We will even combine clubs. This relay will be nominated on the day and coaches will be responsible for this relay. 12x25m Freestyle mixed 6 boys, 6 girls of which 4 swimmers 12&U, 4 swimmers 15&O and 4 swimmers Open (to all ages).
- 14. Programmes will be available on the FNQ website along with a DRAFT timeline.
- 15. In the event of a protest, \$100 fee to be deposited with a written protest not later than 30 minutes following the conclusion of the event (SAL CBL 12).
- 16. This is an FNQ Swimming run event, accordingly all clubs will be allocated tasks for the weekend.
- 17. It is a condition of entering this event that your club understands that timekeeping is required by all clubs and is allocated by the number of swimmers your club enters.

AWARDS

- 1. Individual events will be multi aged events for awards except 11&O 50m events. The 11&O 50m events, the awards will be presented to the first three placegetters only. The events for the distance champions will be awarded to the first three placegetters in the age range 14&U and 15&O age groups.
- 2. Swimmers aged 8, 9 and 10 years will be awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd place medals.
- 3. Complete Swimmer medal will be awarded to 8, 9 and 10 years upon **completion** of all four 50m events (event numbers: Boys 17, 21, 43 and 49; Girls 18, 22, 44 and 50). You **must swim** the event to be eligible for the Complete Swimmer Medal.
- 4. Multi-class (SWD) swimmers will be awarded medals in all 50m events. There is no separate multi-class event, these swimmers will enter the relevant events to promote and encourage inclusivity and competitiveness.
- 5. Awards will be presented for all first three place getters in all relay events except event 65.
- 6. Awards for age champion winners, runners up and third place getters in the following age groups: 8yrs, 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs, 17&Over & Multi-class.
- 7. Points for the club and individual awards will be given to the first 6 place getters as follows: First 10, Second 7, Third 5, Fourth 3, Fifth 2 and Sixth 1.
- 8. Distance events will be multi aged for award medals (14&U and 15&O) for all 200m form stroke events, 400IM and the 200, 400, 800 and 1500 freestyle events.
- 9. Championship Points: 50m events, as well as age, form and freestyle aggregate events contribute to overall club championship points.
- 10. Visitors do not score points but will receive a medal for placing.
- 11. Age Champions will be determined by points accrued In the following (you do not have to do all events to be eligible for the award):
 - i. 8, 9 and 10 years 50m of each stroke and 100IM
 - ii. 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17&O 100m of each stroke and 200IM
 - iii. Multi-class 50m of each stroke
