KEY DETAILS

- This meet has been designed to provide a quality racing opportunity for swimmers prior to nominating for the FNQ Short Course Championships.
- Competition is conducted under the laws of Swimming Australia Ltd and with the permission of Swimming Queensland.
- 3. Protests must be submitted in writing to the Referee by a responsible team leader, together with a deposit of \$100 within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the respective event.
- Competitors must be a current financial registered member of a club affiliated with Swimming Queensland as at the closing date of the meet entries.
- 5. Age of competitors is calculated at the first day of the meet
- 6. Referee has the power to control events at his/her discretion
- 7. All events will be timed finals.
- 8. No multi-class events, however athletes with an impairment may enter in any event specific to their age and are required to present their classification card to the referee prior to the start of the meet.
- In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed/videoed, and these images may be used by TAS Swimming at its discretion.
- 10. Entries are to be completed online via Swim Central. Entries close Midnight of the Monday prior to the meet.
- 11. Entry Fee is \$7.50 per event including all FNQ surcharges. Spectator Entry is \$3/adult.
- 12. An entry list will be published and emailed to all clubs on Tuesday prior to the meet, any discrepancies must be submitted to TAS Swimming Race Secretary by Wednesday prior to the meet.
- 13. An online program will be published on FNQ and TAS Swimming websites on the Thursday prior to the meet. No printed programs will be available. The timeline published for this meet is to be used as a guide only, start times of events may vary depending on circumstances on the day of competition.
- 14. No refunds will be issued once the program has been published
- 15. A timekeeper roster will be confirmed and published as part of the program. Timekeeping is allocated by the number of swimmers entered from each club
- 16. Late entries will be accepted up until 30 minutes prior to the meet start time and incur a fee of \$15 per event.
- 17. Results will be viewable on Meet Mobile. Results will be multiaged as per Swimming Queensland Competition Guidelines. No medals will be presented at this meet.
