- All competitors must be currently registered members of an affiliated SAL club (except for Junior Tadpole competitors)
- All decisions taken will be at the discretion of the Chief Referee of the day
- 4. Age shall be as at the first day of the meet
- Swimmers must nominate through Swim Central
- 6. Nomination fee: \$7.50 per event including all surcharges
- 7. Spectator entry: \$3 per adult
- 8. Late nominations accepted 60 minutes prior to meet start time,\$15 per event late fee applies
