Following the success and positive feedback from the recent Marlin Coast event, we are excited to continue with the same at this carnival.

This 12 years & under carnival will feature:

- A Skill Challenge: Streamline butterfly kick for 25m across TAS pool with fins (don't forget to bring your fins!)
- A program of shorter races designed to introduce new swimmers to racing, gain confidence and give developing swimmers the chance to improve their racing skills.

As this is a junior-focused meet, we won't require the usual extended warm-up.

- **Entry from 5:00pm** – allowing swimmers time to prepare and practice skills.
- Skill Challenge at 5:45pm – scheduled at the end of warm-up.
- Racing from just after 6:00pm, following the placement of timekeepers.

We look forward to welcoming you poolside for an evening of fun, learning, and racing!

KEY DETAILS

1. This meet has been designed to provide a quality racing opportunity for swimmers in the FNQ region.
2. This meet is open to Swimming Queensland registered competitive swimmers; other swimmers may enter if they meet state, territory or country clearance criteria.
3. In nominating for this meet, swimmers agree that they may be photographed/videoed, and these images may be used by TAS Swimming at its discretion.
4. Age will be calculated as at the first day of this meet.
5. Entries are to be completed online via Swim Central using the link available on our website.
Entries close Midnight of the Monday prior to the meet.
6. Entry Fees: Entry \$7.50 per event including all surcharges.
7. An entry list will be published and emailed to all clubs on Tuesday prior to the meet, any discrepancies must be submitted to Saints Race Secretary by Wednesday prior to the meet.
8. Late entries will be accepted up until 30 minutes prior to the meet start time and incur a fee of \$15 per event.
9. Spectator Entry \$3/adult.
10. An online program will be published on FNQ and TAS Swimming websites on the Thursday prior to the meet. No printed programs will be available. The timeline published for this meet is to be used as a guide only, start times of events may vary depending on circumstances on the day of competition.
11. A timekeeper roster will be confirmed and published as part of the program. Timekeeping is allocated by the number of swimmers entered from each club.
12. Events are conducted as timed finals and swum on a “seeded-entry” basis. Heats are seeded fastest to slowest. Starts will be ‘over the top’, competitors will remain in their respective lanes until the next heat is started.
13. Heats may be amalgamated or re-seeded at the discretion of the Technical Manager and Referee.
14. Results will be viewable on Meet Mobile. Results will be multi-aged as per Swimming Queensland Competition Guidelines.
15. Swimming Australia Rules will apply at this meet. Protests must be submitted in writing to the Referee by a responsible team leader, together with a deposit of \$100 within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the respective event.
